



2021-2022 AP U.S. HISTORY SUMMER READING

Welcome to AP U.S. History. You have chosen to undertake an extremely challenging course, but one that I hope will also be incredibly rewarding. In order to make the most efficient use of our time, we will be completing most of the first unit of study over the summer rather than doing a traditional summer reading assignment.

The summer material will focus on content from the exploration of the New World through the beginning of the French and Indian War (APUSH Periods 1 and 2). You will have several assignments to complete and lectures from which to take notes that will be due on the first day of class. We will spend the first four days of class reviewing the material and going over several procedural things related to AP U.S. History. You will then have a test over the material from chapters 1-3 on the fifth class (August 23/24).

In order for you to complete the assignments, a course has been created in Google Classroom specifically for your summer work (called AP U.S. History Summer Assignments).
