

**RISING KINDERGARTEN/TK
SUMMER PACKET**



Dear PK4 Families,

Summer is such a WONDERFUL time of the year to take a break and enjoy family time! As you are enjoying this break from school, we encourage you to set aside little moments 3-4 times a week for “school time.” The children have worked VERY hard this year and have learned SO much! We do not want them to lose any of these important skills over the summer. As you are planning your days, we would encourage you to continue to have your child practice the following skills in preparation for Kindergarten or TK:

-Writing their name (one uppercase, followed by lowercase)

-Identifying numbers 0 – 20 (out of order)

-Identifying letters (uppercase and lowercase) **and letter sounds** (out of order)

**letter formation page below*

-Writing letters (uppercase and lowercase)

-Writing in their Writing Journal (Choose a topic: i.e. “draw your favorite ocean animal.” They will draw the picture and then try to INDEPENDENTLY spell/write what they drew. For example, they might write “se otr” for “sea otter.”)

-Practice cutting

-Read, read, read! (Move your finger along the words as you read to your child. They will learn from you!!)

- Fine Motor Fun:

1. Draw and write with sidewalk chalk and spray it “clean” with a squirt bottle of water.
2. Make a cutting box with kid-sized scissors and various items to cut: paper, tissue, cardstock, ribbon, etc. Or go outside and “cut the grass!”
3. Play with Play Dough (Put a tray under the play dough for easy clean-up)
4. Use a Hole Punch (They LOVE this!)

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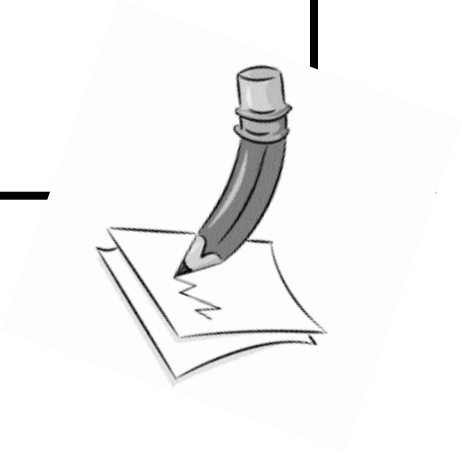
