<b>Qualifications:</b>	Certified employee of MPCCS; experience in coaching the particular sport; excellent verbal communication skills; impeccable organization and management skills. All duties and responsibilities are essential job functions and requirements and are subject to possible modification to reasonably accommodate individuals with disabilities. <b>Physical Requirements:</b>	Lifting and transporting athletic equipment and boxes not exceeding 40 pounds
<b>Responsibilities:</b>	Responsibilities of the Coach are as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Maintaining a Christ-centered atmosphere at practices and contests</li><li>○ Fostering good sportsmanship among athletes</li><li>○ Explaining eligibility requirements to athletes and ensures compliance</li><li>○ Supervising all athletes at all times scheduled for practices/competitions</li><li>○ Ensuring that all forms, including physicals, emergency release and insurance waiver forms are turned in</li><li>○ Assigning assistant coaches upon approval of the Athletic Director</li><li>○ Meeting before each season with each assistant coach to determine their individual responsibilities</li><li>○ Attending professional meetings as necessary and remains aware of current trends and changes</li><li>○ Attending coaching clinics</li><li>○ Maintaining current inventory of all athletic equipment</li><li>○ Coordinating the distribution, collection and storage of athletic equipment and collects fees for lost equipment and uniforms</li><li>○ Ensuring collection of all athletic fees pertaining to the sport</li><li>○ Organizing pre-season parent/coach meeting</li><li>○ Cooperating and provides leadership with/to the booster club</li><li>○ Promoting professional ethics</li><li>○ Complying with conditions as stated in employee contract and handbook</li><li>○ Modeling appropriate Christian behavior in speech and actions</li><li>○ Any other duties as assigned</li></ul>
