

# Guidelines for Dress Down Days

Throughout the year, students will have the opportunity to participate in “dress-down” days. The guidelines for these days are listed below.

## **General rules:**

- Attire must be modest.
- Clothes cannot be worn too baggy or too tight.
- Jeans and pants should be worn at the waist. No ripped jeans.
- No sweatpants
- If a student is serving as a tutor or an aide in one of the other schools divisions, uniform attire must be worn.
- No political statements.
- No inappropriate logos or advertisements

**The administration reserves the right to require students to change clothes if the attire is deemed inappropriate.**

## **Boys:**

- Uniform shorts
- Athletic shorts the same length as uniform shorts
- Jeans with no rips/holes
- Shirts with school-appropriate logos
- No political or social movement logos
- No sweat pants/PJs
- No cut-offs
- No sleeveless shirts
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## **Girls:**

- Uniform skorts
- Jeans with no rips/holes
- Leggings with a shirt that covers your bottom
- Shirts with school-appropriate logos
- No political or social movement logos

- No sweat pants/PJs
- No cut-offs
- No sleeveless shirts
- No crop tops
- No shorts or skirts/skorts

**If you are not adhering to these guidelines, you must be in normal school attire.**
