Permission to drive to Mount Paran Christian School is a privilege. Students are always expected to abide by all school regulations and exhibit safe driving. The parking lot of Mount Paran Christian School is school property and subject to all school policies and procedures as outlined in the school handbook. Any action not in compliance with school policies will be dealt with accordingly.

- All student drivers will be assigned a parking place obtained through the high school office. Students are not to park in any other parking space during the course of the school day, unless they have been granted permission to do so. Parking in a handicapped area or a designated parking space for visitors, staff, etc. is prohibited.
- Students must abide by all parking and driving guidelines, including any **posted speed limits**. If a speed limit is not posted, the speed limit is 10 MPH.
- When students arrive at school, they must leave their cars and enter the building. There is to be no loitering in the parking lot before and after school.
- Students (non-seniors) are not to return to their cars during the school day without specific permission from a faculty member or administrator.
- Students may not drive their vehicles from one parking lot to another during the course of the school day. This includes driving to the Murray Arts Center, sports fields, or Knox Performance Center.
- Students may not transport another in any vehicle without parental permission.
- Any student who leaves the MPCS campus during the course of the school day without parent permission will automatically lose their on-campus driving privileges for the remainder of the semester.
- Student's parking permit sticker should always be visible and placed in the lower driver's side of the front windshield.
- Reckless or careless conduct with a vehicle is unacceptable.
- MPCS shall not be responsible for the losses or damages to the property of users of its facilities including loss to bodily injury.
- A student's parking privilege will be revoked when his/her license is suspended. The school administration must be notified immediately when the license is revoked.
- Student drivers should abide by all driving laws in any neighboring subdivision. Consequences may occur to students who are reported as violators of such laws.
- Any student who violates any parking and traffic guidelines shall be subject to the consequences deemed appropriate by the administration, including the indefinite or permanent loss of their school parking permit.
- Only senior drivers are permitted to leave for lunch if their free block falls on second or third block.

<i>On-campus driving violation consequences are as follows but not limited to:</i>

First offense: warning

Second offense: loss of parking spot and driving privileges suspended for up to two weeks

Third offense: on-campus driving privileges suspended for semester

Fourth offense: on-campus driving privileges revoked indefinitely
