2021-2022 EAGLE ADVENTURE ZONE (EAZ) AND THE ZONE EXTENDED DAY RATES AND FINANCIAL CONTRACT

A non-refundable, non-transferable deposit of \$50 will be required for students enrolled in the EAZ or The Zone program on a regular basis. The deposit then will be applied to the annual extended-day charge and will be billed with the first payment due for EAZ or The Zone after school care. A deposit is not required for Drop-Ins.

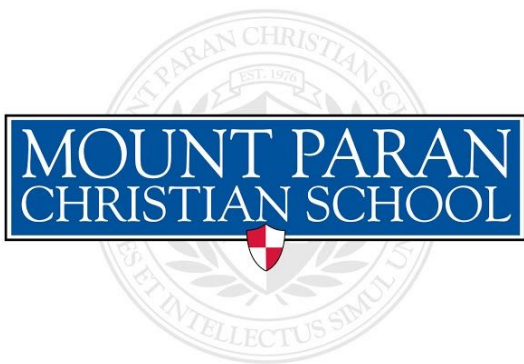
Note: The EAZ program payment plan will be the same as the selected student tuition payment plan.

Full Payment — Due on or before June 1, 2021.

3 Payments*— First payment due on or before June 1, 2020. Second payment due on or before October 1, 2021, Third payment due on or before February 1, 2022

10 Payments*— First payment due on or before the June 1, 2020. Subsequent payments will be due monthly July 1, 2021 - April 1, 2022. No scheduled payment will be due in December 2021.

- If an account falls thirty (30) days past due, the parents and/or guarantors will be contacted, and the student will not be allowed to attend EAZ until the tuition is paid to an up-to-date status. The account will be subject to appropriate penalties including all late fees.
- Withdrawal from extended-day programs during the year will require pro-ration of yearly fees along with a withdrawal fee of 1/10 of the yearly ten-pay amount.
- Any changes in EAZ or The Zone enrollment after the re-enrollment or new student enrollment will result in a \$50 change fee.
- All other terms and conditions stated on the Tuition Financial Contract apply to this contract as well.



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2021-2022 MPCS EAGLE ADVENTURE ZONE AND THE ZONE POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ATTENDANCE POLICIES:

- Students not picked up from carpool by the end of dismissal time are not permitted to roam on campus. They will be checked in to EAZ or The Zone program and charged the daily fee. Daily rates will apply.
- The extended day program hours are 3:10-6:00 p.m. There is a snack provided. You must be prompt in picking up your child at the conclusion of the enrolled session.
- **A late fee at the rate of \$2.00 per minute will be assessed. This fee is expected at the time of pickup on the date in which the late fee was accrued.** If the child has been picked up late five times, there will be an additional \$10 fee charged and the child may be removed from the program. The classroom clocks will be utilized as the official time. If late fees remain unpaid after five school days, the student may not attend extended day programs until payment balance is clear.
- Parents will be notified immediately of any illness or serious injury to the child. In the event that your child becomes ill and must leave the school, arrangements should be made to pick up your child within the hour. The child will be moved to a quiet area away from other children where he/she will receive the necessary attention until the parent arrives. Children are not permitted to stay at the school while experiencing fever, diarrhea, vomiting or exhibiting signs of contagious diseases or adverse reactions to any medication.
- Students may not attend extended-day programs if they were not present in school on that day. EAZ and The Zone is only offered on days when school is in session. Early release days may be offered at an additional fee.

GENERAL POLICIES:

- Drop-in care after school dismissal will be available when space is available. A drop-in is a student who does not regularly attend extended day programs but comes on occasion. **There must be one school day's notice for any students utilizing the EAZ program as a drop-in.** Arrangements must be made with the Auxiliary Director twenty-four (24) hours in advance. For advance arrangements, the charge will be \$10.00 for drop-in care from 3:10-4:00 p.m. or \$25 if your child stays until 6:00 p.m. (\$50 if 24-hour notice is not given). Payment is due the day the student stays in EAZ. All students who participate in the EAZ Program must have completed EAZ registration forms on file. No child will be permitted to participate in the program until all necessary forms have been completed and submitted to the Director. Payment for drop-in care is to be paid to the Director and is due at time of pick up.
- EAZ and The Zone two-day and three-day dates are pre-determined and cannot be negotiated.
- Payments need to be made to the business office, for students enrolled full-time in EAZ or The Zone, no later than the tenth day of each month to avoid a late fee. Payments for drop-in basis are to be made to the Auxiliary Director on the date the charge is accrued. If drop-in fees are added to the student's account, the business office will assess a service charge. An outstanding balance extending past 30 days overdue will be processed through student accounts in the business office.
- Withdrawal from EAZ or The Zone during the year will require pro-ration of the annual fee along with a withdrawal fee of 1/10 of the yearly ten-pay program amount. In addition, any changes in the program enrollment in The Zone will result in a \$50 change fee. All other terms and conditions stated on the Tuition Financial Contract apply to this contract as well.
- For the protection of children, the EAZ program follows all procedures of the school regarding severe weather, fire, physical plant problems, and structural damage. If any of these events occur, you will be contacted as soon as possible.

- *Discipline:* The ZONE and EAZ program is an extension of the regular classroom. The approach of positive reinforcement to correct behavior will be used. The specific details of the behavior management program will be modified for the age of each group. In the case that an inappropriate behavior has been exhibited, an explanation of the behavior and the explanation of the expected correct behavior will be sent home. Redirection of the student will take place in a progression: warning, timeout, removal from class, meeting with the director and/or meeting with the lower school head. Any behavior difficulties that are exhibited on a regular basis will be addressed by the lower or middle school head and may result in removal from the EAZ program. At any time, a student may be removed from EAZ at the direction of the lower school head for behavior infractions against the covenant statement.
- Extended-day programs cannot take any responsibility for lost or broken personal articles.
- Students enrolled in the EAZ or The Zone program may be given the opportunity to participate in additional activities in other parts of the building (i.e. gym, library, etc.). The signature on the registration forms will serve as an in-house permission to remain on file.
- Students will need to be signed out of EAZ by a parent or other authorized person.
- If a child is to be released to anyone other than the parent, guardian, or other previously approved persons, the Auxiliary Director is to be notified in writing of the change. Additionally, we request that you notify us in writing of any persons who are *not* allowed to pick up your child.
- If a child is not picked up by 8:00 p.m., and no communication has been received from the parents, the child will be turned over to the appropriate Cobb County authorities.
