Seniors may decorate their Senior Spots with an approved school "spirit" design. Designs must be approved by Ms. Karr, must honor our school community, and include a scripture reference.

JULY 26 — Before Painting

Seniors should secure a parking spot on Tuesday, July 26 from 8:30-10:30 a.m. with Mrs. Palomaki in the high school office. Students may sign up for themselves and one friend only with pre-approval. The driver application, copy of your Senior Spot design sketch, and \$25 fee must be submitted. (Please, no political or otherwise divisive designs!) Seniors may choose a spot in the designated "painting zone" on a first-come, first-served basis. It is the student's responsibility to provide all the necessary painting supplies to decorate his/her spot.

JULY 29 — Priming Day

Students MUST prime their spot on Friday, July 29, 5:00-8:00 p.m., arriving by 6:30 p.m. at the latest. Please verify your spot location before priming and use the recommended "Gray Gripper." You may have your primer tinted the color of your background to save a step. You may not paint over parking spot #s. You must leave a 6 inch border around all sides.

JULY 30 — Painting Day

Official painting day is Saturday, July 30, from 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. All painting must be completed by 4:00 p.m.! Parking lot will be coned off and NO cars will be allowed in painting areas Friday or Saturday.

Use tape to mask off. Do not paint outside the existing lines. Sketch your design with chalk and paint. You must take your trash and any unused supplies with you! Do not discard paint, trays, rollers, etc. at school. Students are responsible for touch-up and maintenance throughout the year.
